The Fund aims to provide investors with a moderate long term total return by providing them with exposure to a diverse mix of underlying portfolios, comprising global asset classes and exposure to various currencies. Investments to be included in the portfolio will, apart from assets in liquid form, consists of participatory interests and other forms of participation of local and global collective investment schemes, or other similar schemes operated in territories with a regulatory environment which is to the satisfaction of the manager and trustee of a sufficient standard to provide investor protection at least equivalent to that in South Africa and which is consistent with the portfolio's primary objective, investing in amongst others, equity securities, property securities, non-equity securities, money market instruments, preference shares, listed and unlisted financial instruments, bonds and other interest bearing instruments and securities.

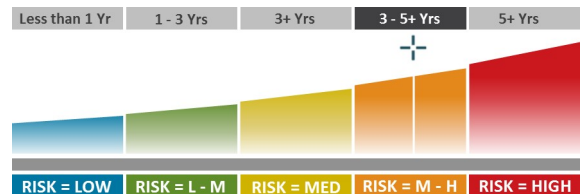

### Medium - High Risk

- This portfolio holds more equity exposure than a medium risk portfolio but less than a high-risk portfolio.
